4. Registration process (From 24 October – 19 December 2011)

- 2) Present the pay-in slip and complete the pink registration at the Program Office **from 24 October to 19 December 2011; Monday-Friday 8.30-16.30** ****Due to the flooding situation, you may call the Office to make sure it is open before you come)**
- 3) For MA/IS students, please note that surveys of electives conducted last year were not an official sign-up or registration of the electives. Your selection of electives in this registration period can be different from that in the previous surveys. Please also note that the maximum number of students for an elective is 22. **The Program will use the 'first-come-first-served' basis for registration of electives. Students who register for an elective after it has reached the maximum number will be asked to choose another available course instead.** Please also note that, according to the new syllabus structure, first-year students will take 2 electives in this coming semester as well.
- 4) MA and PhD students who wish to take 'audit' credits for some of the electives to be offered next semester have to pay 'full' tuition fees for the course (3,000 baht/credit for MA; 5,000 baht/credit for PhD). Please consult your advisor or the Program Office before audit registration (e.g. to choose the most useful courses or to avoid class conflicts; and the total registration should not exceed 12 credits including Audits)
