- 3) For MA students, please note that surveys of electives conducted this semester were not an official sign-up or registration of the electives. Your selection of electives in this registration period can be different from that in the previous surveys. Please also note that the maximum number of students for an elective is 22. **The Program will use the 'first-come-first-served' basis for registration of electives. Students who register for an elective after it has reached the maximum number will be asked to choose another available course instead.** Please also note that, according to the old syllabus structure, second-year students in IS Plan will take 2 electives in this coming semester as well.
